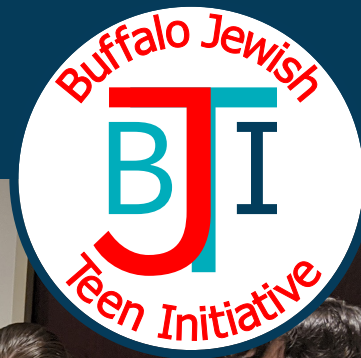

- Antisemitism
- Kashrut (Kosher)
- Israel
