It is an evolving and collaborative space for the exploration of this region's diverse Jewish histories and heritages. A year-round, 24/7 online resource for Jewish American heritage in Buffalo, it also holds occasional in person convenings, and traveling exhibitions.

What is Jewish American Heritage Month?



Jewish American Heritage Month (JAHM) is a national month-long observance that recognizes over 360 years of Jewish contributions to American culture, celebrated each May from 2006 with a Presidential Proclamation. JAHM recognizes and honors the contributions American Jews have made, and continue to make, to American history, culture, and society. <u>You can</u> read the history of how JAHM came to fruition and this year's Presidential Proclamation for 2023.
