This individual will work closely with volunteer leaders to mobilize community members and bring the vision of LiNK to life. Additionally, the Senior Director of Jewish Experience supervises the Director of Jewish Experience and other program staff.

Responsibilities & Duties

- **Strategic Planning:** Lead strategic planning and visioning for the Federation engagement efforts by overseeing data collection, management, and assessment to inform annual and multi-year strategy development, ensuring alignment with organizational goal and community needs.
- Leadership & Oversight: Serve as the professional lead for LiNK Jewish Buffalo, overseeing all programmatic, operational, and staff functions, donor solicitation and stewardship, and volunteer partnerships with the LiNK Leadership Council.
- **Community & Stakeholder Engagement:** Build, maintain, and deepen relationships with individuals from a wide variety of constituent groups across Jewish Buffalo, Federation senior leadership, partner agencies, congregations, and external organizations to ensure support for Jewish Individuals and families and to develop meaningful collaborations.
- **Program Vision & Execution:** Partner with volunteer leadership and your team of professionals to envision, plan, and execute a dynamic portfolio of annual Jewish living, learning, and engagement opportunities.
- **Teaching & Facilitation:** Design curriculum and facilitate Jewish educational programs and gatherings for learners of all ages.
